Dr. Kingwell has lectured to popular and academic audiences around the world and is one of Canada's foremost public intellectuals and author of sixteen books, including *The World We Want: Restoring Citizenship in a Fractured Age*. As the Professor of Philosophy at the University of Toronto, his work has explored such questions as the role of empathy in creating social change, social obligation and citizenship in a democratic society, and the ethics and politics of the built environment.

Julian Smith

Off the Grid - New Directions in Heritage Conservation

Julian Smith will address what Gustavo Araoz, President of ICOMOS, refers to as a new paradigm in the heritage conservation field. It is a shift from a primarily commemorative and aesthetic perspective to an ecological perspective. It is more dynamic than static, more embedded in the broader community, less concerned with designation, and has stronger ties to contemporary design and development. Julian will use examples drawn from both Canadian and international sources to illustrate these ideas.

Sandra Massey

Remembering, Storytelling and Public History: Connecting Living Heritage with Quality of Life

Sandra's plenary will focus on the concept of living heritage and its implications in a pluralistic world. Exploring the role of storytelling and public history in shaping our sense of identity, belonging and place highlights the implicit connections between living heritage and contemporary quality of life issues. With a democratic mandate the heritage community will ensure responsible stewardship of heritage resources and provide opportunities for the ongoing negotiation of shared public values. This Plenary will be followed by **FORUM "TWEETS"** where a number of presenters will share their experience depicting the range of heritage-related activities that are outside the traditional perception of heritage.
