Dr. Ernie Walker – Keynote Speaker at 2020 Heritage Forum in Saskatoon

The [Heritage Forum](#) takes place at the Western Development Museum in Saskatoon this Thursday February 27th, with Dr. Ernie Walker giving the keynote address. The Forum theme is *Our Places – Our Stories That Matter*. Dr. Ernie Walker’s keynote address, *Tales from the Big Empty, the Improbable Story of Wanuskewin Heritage Park*, tells the improbable story of the development of Wanuskewin, with a focus on some of the most significant events that have transpired over the past 40 years.

Other presentations will highlight projects including – *Telling the Stories of Place through Craft Beer*; *Places of Faith – an Unknown Future*; *Redeveloping Heritage Places – King Edward School, Calgary*; and a panel, *Pathways to Success*, highlighting tourism initiatives.
