April 30, 2021

The Board of Directors of Heritage Saskatchewan met virtually on April 30, 2021, where we accepted, with regret, the resignation of one of our Directors, Tamara Pearl. This Board meeting followed a two-part orientation session for the incoming Board Members, and in addition to standard governance monitoring, we appointed our committees for this year, and Vice President Erin Folk led us through an introduction to risk management.
