



Board Meeting Synopsis

October 23, 2021

The Board met virtually on October 23 for a session on Risk Management, followed by a Board meeting and discussion on trends and issues. The Risk Assessment will continue over the next few meetings, and though it does take significant time and engagement, it is significant and meaningful work for the longevity of Heritage Saskatchewan. The Board meeting portion went well and there were no issues arising.

After the regular business, the Board discussed land acknowledgements and how we wish to proceed.
