

Heritage Saskatchewan Board Meeting Synopsis September 26 & 27, 2025

Heritage Saskatchewan's Board met at Government House in Regina, on September 26 and 27, 2025. In addition to our regular board business reports and monitoring, we reviewed our Ends Statement and concluded that the statement remains relevant but added the definition of wellbeing. Heritage Saskatchewan's definition of wellbeing comes from our Saskatchewan Index of Wellbeing (2019) report, "How are Residents of Saskatchewan Really Doing?", and states "Wellbeing is achieved when people are physically, emotionally and spiritually healthy; economically secure; have a strong sense of identity, belonging and place; and have the confidence and capacity to engage as citizens." Our CEO provided the Board with information on work being done on the business case for cultural heritage and on advocacy. Board members engaged in a lively discussion around these topics.
